House of Representatives Senate Bill 2293 Conference Report

Requires that schools that have been rated as failing for 3 consecutive years be converted to New Start Schools and be placed under the administration of the Recovery School District. The report further provides that schools that have been rated as failing, low performing or at risk of failing for 3 consecutive years may be converted to charter status upon a majority vote of the parents of the children enrolled in the school and upon approval of the State Board of Education. Parents would elect a management board to oversee the operation of the charter school.
