House of Representatives House Amendment to Senate Bill 2688

Utilizes \$79-million from the Health Care Expendable Fund and the Public Service Commission to restore cuts to education and other state agencies. Restores \$33.9-million to the Mississippi Adequate Education Program, \$1.93-million to the National Board Certified Teacher Program, \$1.06-million to the Chickasaw Cession Interest Payment, and \$611,782 to General Education Programs for a total of \$37.6-million to K-12 education.

The Parents' Campaign favors a yea vote on this amendment.
