House of Representatives House Bill 1622

Appropriates funding for K-12 education for Fiscal Year 2011 (the coming school year). Funds MAEP at 5.5% below the original appropriation for the current school year. (An additional \$158-million would be required to fully fund MAEP for FY11). The National Board Certified Teacher program, Educable Child, and Chickasaw Cession are fully funded.
