### House of Representatives House Bill 1622 Conference Report

Funds K-12 education at \$80.5-million below the FY10 actual appropriation (net after budget cuts) and \$232-million below full funding for the Mississippi Adequate Education Program; fully funds the Chickasaw Session interest payment and the National Board Certification Program.
