Senate Bryan Amendment to House Bill 1622

The Bryan Amendment increases by \$27-million the Senate level of funding for MAEP and by \$2-million the Senate level of funding for the National Board Certified Teacher program; it adds an additional \$50-million to MAEP if additional funds are made available from a U.S. Congressional change in states' Medicaid reimbursement rate.

The Parents' Campaign favors a yea vote on this amendment.
