Senate House Bill 1170 Blount Amendment to HB 1170

The amendment removes the provision that allows a reduction in instructional days. It retains the provision to allow school districts to designate up to 3 furlough days, preferably non-instructional days, for the remainder of this school year. For two years, 2011 and 2012, it allows a reduction in staff development days from 7 to 2, allows a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 5 furlough days and allows local school district to reduce local supplement pay for employees.
