Senate House Bill 1170 Senate Amendment to HB1170

Mandates employees be furloughed for 2 days of the 7 staff development days that are built into teacher contracts and the salaries be adjusted accordingly; allows an additional 3 furlough days which also must be taken from staff development days; allows local districts flexibility in local supplements; reduces the minimum number of instructional days from 180 to 175 but does not allow a corresponding reduction in teacher salaries. Districts will not be required to fill days required for the 2009-2010 school year lost due to inclement weather.
